All international students who apply for admission to the University of Notre Dame must also submit a Certification of Finances at the time of application. The I-20 or DS-2019 will be used to apply for the F-1 or J-1 visa, or a change of status to the F-1 or J-1 status from within the United States. The I-20 or DS-2019 will be issued by the University upon admission and confirmation to enroll at the University of Notre Dame.
